INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE ELIMINATION OF RACIAL DISCRIMINATION March 21, 2018

- Whereas:** every person is entitled to human rights without discrimination; and
- Whereas:** Article 1 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights states that all human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights; and
- Whereas:** based on Article 2 everyone is entitled to all rights and freedoms set forth in the declaration without distinction of race or any other kind; and
- Whereas:** racism, xenophobia and intolerance are problems prevalent in all societies and discriminatory practices are widespread; and
- Whereas:** the City of Prince George is a municipality committed to taking action to create a welcoming, inclusive community; and
- Whereas:** we acknowledge the need to raise awareness about racism and discrimination and the role that we can all play towards eliminating it.
