## What does the existing OCP say?

- Aims to provide municipal infrastructure that protects public health and safety.
- Seeks to reduce and/or effectively manage impacts on the environment and climate change.
- Lists infrastructure projects that were identified in master servicing plans.

### What We Heard

- Infrastructure planning is a high priority for you and should be a high priority for us.
- Land north of the Nechako River is constrained by a lack of servicing capacity.
- We should invest in upgrading existing infrastructure rather than servicing new growth areas.
- Upgrades to existing services and utilities are required for businesses to thrive in PG.
- We should build infrastructure that better connects us to the riverfront.

Municipal infrastructure provides the foundation for our community and includes water supply and distribution, sewage collection and wastewater treatment, stormwater management, roads, solid waste management and recycling and utilities.









## **Proposed Policy Direction**

- Focus growth and development in existing built-up areas where services already exist.
- Better align infrastructure planning with growth management planning.
- Incorporate more green infrastructure policies to better protect air, water, nature and wildlife.
- Introduce infrastructure policies that address climate change and emergency preparedness based on the latest science, technology and best practices.
- Provide for the regular updating of master servicing plans.
