The Advisory Committee on Bear Awareness is responsible to advise Council and staff on opportunities to increase bear-proofing and reduce bear attractants throughout Prince George to minimize human-bear conflicts in the community and promote public safety and bear safety.

Meetings will be scheduled Monday to Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. The committee meeting schedule will be determined at the inaugural meeting in early July 2024.

Members of the committee are expected to meet regularly during its four-month term and to engage in research and information gathering activities to best inform the committee's recommendations to Council.
